FLIPPED IMPACT PROJECT IS LOOKING FOR 4 PRE-SERVICE TEACHERS IN 2019-2020 ACADEMIC YEAR !

Flipped Impact Project is an multinational Erasmus+ project co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union incorporating partners from *Turkey, The Netherlands, Lithuania, Spain and Romania*. FIP aims to plan, apply and assess the impact of Flipped Learning on K-12 learners' learning outcomes and the effectiveness of teaching through technology-driven Flipped Learning activities with the cooperation between K-12 schools and universities collaboratively.

The Opportunities within the scope of the Project:

- * A fully-funded visit to Lithuania - 5 Days, December, 2019 (Learning/Teaching/Training)
- * A fully-funded visit to Spain - 5 Days, April, 2020 (Learning/Teaching/Training)
- * An Erasmus+ Certificate for Each Learning/Teaching/Training Activity

Requirements:

- * having interest in teaching, technology integration, online materials design and flipped approach
- * preferably having taken courses related to CALL or audio-visual aids in ELT
- * being enthusiastic about learning how to use ICT tools in teaching
- * having personal qualities such perseverance and commitment
- * willingness to work collaboratively and solve problems

Implementation Process:

- *The candidates are required to take **FLE 425 School Experience and FLE 404 Practice Teaching** courses in the sections of Dr. Işıl Günseli Kaçar throughout the Fall and Spring Semesters.
- *The candidates must acknowledge that they have **no travel restriction** in the specified dates above.
- *The pre-service teachers admitted to the project are required to teach 4-5 flipped lessons to a small group of students at **METU GVO in both semesters**. The lessons will be conducted at 16-17 p.m.
- *The lessons conducted by the pre-service teachers are to be counted within the scope of observation hours.
- *Each semester, 2 pre-service teachers are granted for the visits. (2 for Lithuania - 2 for Spain Visits)
