- *According to METU criteria for appointment, the candidate who holds a PhD degree from a Turkish university should have spent **at least one academic year** (after having obtained a PhD degree) actively participating in academic research at a reputable university abroad.
- **According to METU criteria for appointment, the candidate should meet **at least one** of the following publication requirements:
- **A.)** 1 full research article published in a journal indexed by **any** of the following: AHCI, WoS Q1, WoS Q2, WoS Q3, Scopus Q1, Scopus Q2 **and** 1 national or international book or book chapter

OR

B.) 1 full research article published in a journal indexed by **any** of the following: AHCI, WoS Q1, WoS Q2, WoS Q3, Scopus Q1, Scopus Q2 **and** 1 presentation delivered at a refereed, international conference

The criteria above are **the minimum requirements** for candidates who have received their PhD degrees **within the last four years** at the time of application.

Candidates who have received their PhD degrees **five or more years earlier** than the time of application should demonstrate steady research output, including **additional** Type A and/or Type B publications indicated above.
